Demonstrated strategic planning and analytical skills

Demonstrated extensive recent experience working with a range of education, employment and disability stakeholders

A self-starter and is self-motivated

Possess strong interpersonal skills

Demonstrated an ability to form networks across education, employment and disability sectors

Understanding of the barriers that currently make it more difficult for people with disability to access tertiary education and subsequent employment

Knowledge of the nature of the education, job services, employment sectors and/or support available to people with disability

Current Driver's Licence

Current National Police Clearance

Valid Working with Children's Check
